

Student's view of mathematics in Estonia at University level

Abstract

The aim of this article is to introduce the final survey about the students' view of mathematics in Estonia at University level and present a synopsis of results relating to students' attitudes, motivations and their achievements in mathematics. The data was collected from 947 first year bachelor students via a questionnaire which utilized a Likert-type scale and open questions. The educational implications of these results are also discussed.
